

HINUERA SCHOOL (#1741)

Enrolment Scheme

Effective from 16 July 2012

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G (3) of the Education Act 1989 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Starting at 51 Matai Road, the boundary travels east to 238 Hinuera Road, encompassing all addresses on Puketutu Road.

The home zone boundary then extends south along Hinuera Road to 378 Hinuera Road incorporating only the houses on the western side of the road.

SH27 addresses between 604 and 7821 and including these addresses are inside in the zone.

From SH27 the boundary heads east on Taihoa South Road up to and including 353 and 348 Taihoa South Road.

SH29 addresses from and including 4397 SH29 (not including any addresses on Moore Rd) are in zone, to number 5786/5785 SH29 as described below.

From the intersection of SH29 and Rangitanuku Road, the boundary extends to and includes 201 Rangitanuku Road.

From 201 Rangitanuku Road the boundary extends to and includes 240 Bayly Road, incorporating Bayly Road addresses above number 240.

All Lake Road and Wells Road addresses are included in the zone.

The boundary intersects SH27 at the intersection of Lake Road, including only SH27 and Rangapai Road addresses North of Lake Road.

From the intersection of Lake Road and SH27 the boundary extends west to and includes 503 Totman Road. Only Totman Road addresses above 503 Totman Road are inside the zone. Nicholson Road addresses are not included in the zone.

West of 503 Totman Road the boundary intersects SH29 at 5786/5785 SH29, including these addresses but not SH29 addresses above them.

The zone includes Taotaoroa Road addresses up to and including 479 Taotaoroa Road.

From 479 Taotaoroa Road the boundary runs north to include numbers 826 and 835 Buckland Road. Mathieson Road addresses are not included in the zone.

The zone includes only those Buckland Road addresses between 835 Buckland Road and the intersection of Puketutu Road, and extends from Puketutu Road to 51 Matai Road, where the zone began.

Both sides of the in-zone roads above are included unless otherwise stated.

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the

school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- First Priority** (This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary)
- Second Priority** must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- Third Priority** must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- Fourth Priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- Fifth Priority** must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school, or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- Sixth Priority** must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group must be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.
